Acczent is manufactured using the most environmentally responsible materials possible while assuring consistency in quality and performance. We use local suppliers as often as we can to reduce the environmental impact from transportation.

Acczent is produced in Clervaux, Luxembourg. The factory applies an environmental management system (ISO 14001) and over the last five years has made numerous improvements:

- Achieved 29% reduction in VOC emissions to the air
- Accomplished a 133% increase in recycled material (sent to our plant in Lentzweiler for recycling) since 2003
